THIS KIT IS AUSTRALIAN MADE, the construction is mainly alloy and stits covering. It has been designed for large baggage space (.95cubic meter) 3 compartments, 1 is forward of the rudder pedals to balance a big load.

Large 42" cabin for long range comfort.. 110kts cruise speed, on a Jabiru 85hp motor

The main fuel tank is 70lts, and other wing or fuse tanks can be fitted. Rigging out of a trailer in 5 min.

Empty weight 279kg MTOW 544kg Payload 265kg 110kts cruise on 85hp VNE 125kts

50-85hp engines can be used.

Stall 40kts Wing span 24' 8" Tail 7' 6" 2 piece removable

Your editor had the opportunity to have a brief fly in the Cheetah at Narromine. First impression is of a good handling, well mannered aircraft with responsive controls. Turns are well balanced due

to differental ailerons. Wing wash out gave very docile stalls with plenty of warning. In short a nice plane to fly.



The kit is of very simple and quick construction, fuselage has a welded steel frame that holds wing u/c and pilot, and the rest is riveted tubes, top decks are sheet metal.

Wing is a double taper, all ribs are molded fibreglass ,to speed construction main spar is a top and bottom angle using solid rivets. Spars attach. in fuselage by double over lap, to each side of fuselage and 2 bolts holding it in place.

Kit comes with all metal, rivets, tubes, sheet, dope, glue and covering ,wheels, breaks, spats, harness, molded wing tips, ribs, cowl, u/c, and bolts. You need to buy your engine, instruments, and paint. Full builder support, and help line is available for all builders.

We also have a single seat model.(Same aircraft) (SUPER DIAMOND) \$12,500.00 AUD
