
The Poker Run 2007 is set for Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> of July SOCIAL DIRECTOR

## QUA CLUBHOUSE / MEETING ROOM UPDATE



The above drawing shows the basic plan of the proposed QUA Clubhouse.

Since last month's general meeting, progress has been made with new quotes, and a contract signed. Soon application documentation will be forwarded to the WBMA Board of Management and the Water Board for approval of the building. Once the Water Board sign off on the project, application will be made to the Esk Shire Council, so Chris Gratton Sheds can erect the building to the lock up stage. Even though the budget is very tight, it was decided to include the front veranda in the initial construction. A little more work needs to done to plan the toilet / shower area as this is required to be a unisex, disabled persons with wheel chair access. A drainage / plumbing plan also needs to be done for the drainage application. More details will be revealed at the next general meeting in August.
