AIRCRAFT OF THE MONTH

Rand Kar X-AIR



This month's aircraft needs no introduction as examples of it have been flying in Australia for nearly ten years, since local distributor and importer Michael Coates introduced them to the Australian market. With over 1,000 examples now flying in most parts of the world, very few problems with this design have surfaced.

The development and production of this aircraft has an interesting history. Developed from the early Weedhopper design in the United States by a French hang glider enthusiast who has a factory in India, sold via the French office to the world wide market using hardware from India & China, fabric from Germany, powered by an Austrian or an Australian engine with an Australian propeller, and with instruments and radios from other sources, the X-Air has become a truly international aircraft. Despite this mix of ancestry, the basic flying qualities of this aircraft are excellent for the performance levels available in a high drag, fabric and tube design. The stall is non existent at 25 knots airspeed with a gentle mush at the break. Relax the back pressure slightly to continue level flight. With power on, the stall may not happen unless provoked aggressively.

The X-Air is very stable in cruise at 55 to 60 knots with extended hands off stability when trimmed in favorable conditions. The aircraft will show a slight dutch roll characteristic as it automatically corrects for any slight disturbance when flying hands off. The example above was flown from Tamworth to Watts Bridge via Inglewood recently. This one has the Rotax 582, Brolga propeller and the optional 80 litre fuel tanks.

With the large, high lift wing, take off is brisk giving excellent STOL ability when required for any short air strips the pilot may desire to operate from. Your editor has found the X-Air will safely fly out of strips as short as 200 metres at gross weight, as the aircraft will take off and land in half that distance. The X-Air is fully controllable at speeds just above the stall speed when needed during the landing and taking off phase.

The controls are light and feel well matched when flying the aircraft in side slips or tight turns. Cross winds present no problems when landing as the very effective ailerons and powerful rudder give complete control.


ALL IN FLY IN 2009 CANCELLED


